LOCAL APPOINTMENTS LIST 2025 (Prepared in compliance with the Maddy Act)

Pursuant to California Government Code Sections 54970 - 54974, on or before December 31 of each year, the City of Turlock shall prepare an appointments list of all regular and ongoing boards, commissions, and committees which are appointed by the legislative body.

The City of Turlock encourages residents desiring to serve the community to apply for positions on applicable boards, commissions, and committees. The Local Appointments List is as follows:

CDBG COMMUNITY GRANT SELECTION COMMITTEE

The Housing Program Services (HPS) Division provides annual funding to non-profit organizations through a competitive application process. This Federal funding is made available through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program. The City of Turlock is a CDBG entitlement jurisdiction funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD). All CDBG funds must benefit low to moderate income persons in Turlock. Each year, around the beginning of the calendar year, a Notice of Funding Availability (NOFA) is published for the following city fiscal year (July through June). Non-profits may apply for funding to assist individual proposed Public Service activities in Turlock. A variety of activities are assisted with funds from HPS. CDBG funds have assisted activities such as; teen mother services, free food for the low income, cold weather-shelter homeless services, gang prevention services at the local elementary schools and high school.

MEASURE A LOCAL TRANSACTIONS (SALES) AND USE TAX CITIZENS OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE

Pursuant to City of Turlock Ordinance No. 1281-CS, the Measure A Citizens Oversight Committee is comprised of five (5) members, appointed by the City Council. Members of the Citizens' Oversight Committee shall not be current City of Turlock employees, officials, contractors, or vendors of the City. Past employees, officials, contractors, and vendors shall be eligible to serve on the Committee, provided that there are no conflicts of interest as determined by the City Attorney. To the extent possible at least two members of the Committee should be certified public accountants, or have significant background and experience in accounting or a finance related field. Three (3)

members serve two (2) year terms and two (2) members serve three (3) year terms. Successors shall be appointed for terms of three (3) years. No member may serve more than three (3) consecutive terms.

MEASURE L CITIZENS OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE

Measure L is the Transportation Ordinance and Expenditure Plan approved by Stanislaus County voters on November 8, 2016. The measure raises the sales tax in Stanislaus County by one-half cent for a total period of 25 years to improve our local streets and roads, improve connectivity and reduce congestion. This money is administered by the Stanislaus Council of Governments (StanCOG) and pays for specific voter-approved transportation projects for local street and road improvements, and regional projects and transit programs specified in the Plan. Measure L calls for an independent Measure L Oversight Committee to oversee compliance with the Ordinance as specified in the Transportation Ordinance and Plan.

Qualifications: Nominated by local jurisdiction. City representative to StanCOG Policy Board will forward the nomination to StanCOG. Formal appointments are made by the StanCOG Executive Committee.

Term: 3 years

PLANNING COMMISSION

The Planning Commission holds the powers and duties as the “planning agency” for the City of Turlock as defined under Sections 65100 et seq. of the Government Code of the State and such other authority as may be conferred upon the Commission by law. The Planning Commission is the decision-making body for conditional use permits, subdivision maps, comprehensive sign programs, and variances, and serves as the appeal body for any actions or permits delegated to staff by the zoning ordinance. The Turlock Planning Commission is comprised of seven (7) regular and two (2) alternate members, appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council.

Qualifications: Must be a resident of the City of Turlock

Term: Each member serves four (4) year terms with term limits established at twelve (12) consecutive years or end of term in which 12-year period falls. Each alternate member serves a term of two (2) years.

Meeting Times: The Turlock Planning Commission holds regularly scheduled meetings on the first Thursday of each month at Turlock City Hall, 156 S. Broadway, Yosemite Community Room, 6:00 p.m.

TURLOCK MOSQUITO ABATEMENT DISTRICT

The Turlock Mosquito Abatement District is dedicated to enhancing the quality of life for our community by providing effective and environmentally sound mosquito control and disease prevention through timely and efficient surveillance, control and public awareness programs. The District is governed by California Mosquito and Vector Control Law along with an eight (8) member Board of Trustees. The trustees are local residents appointed by city councils and the board of supervisors of Stanislaus County. The District is publicly funded and has monthly board meetings that are open to the public and provides year around service which includes prompt response to service requests, on-site inspections and mosquito control work as necessary. Mosquito fish are available at the District office.
