SUPERVISOR COMMENTS

Dayshift had a busy Sunday with several in-progress incidents requiring multiple officer responses. Officers were dispatched to a subject who had fled out of Emanuel Medical Center against medical advice. The subject was later located and detained on a mental health evaluation. Officers were dispatched to a court order violation in progress. They arrived and found the restrained person inside the protected person's residence. He was arrested and booked. Later in the shift, a large grass fire started along Highway 99, north of Hobby Lobby. Two suspects were located in the area. One was found to be unrelated, but had a felony warrant. He was arrested and booked. The other admitted to accidentally starting the fire. The investigation is still ongoing. The fire burned only the grass in the open lot and there was no apparent property damage.

SUPERVISOR COMMENTS

The shift was steady throughout the night. During this shift, Officers investigated a disturbance between roommates in the 1000 block of Tornell. The argument escalated resulting in one of the roommates stabbing the other on their hand. The suspect was arrested and booked into jail. Officers responded to a vehicle collision with a subject down in the roadway on Lander Ave and the suspect vehicle fleeing the scene. Officers who arrived on scene located the victim and began life saving measures until relieved by TFD/AMR. The victim was transported to an area hospital with life threatening injuries and the

Major Accident Investigations Team was activated. As this was occurring, a reporting party called in that they were following the suspect vehicle. Officers attempted to catch up to them however they were already headed out of the city and prior to doing so, the suspect vehicle crashed in the county and the suspect fled the scene. A perimeter was set up but the suspect was not located. MPD and Stanislaus S. O. responded to assist us with the perimeter and search. This investigation is active.
