## **EMC Health Foundation and United Samaritans Foundation Announce Free Hearing Tests and Aids for Seniors at COSTCO**

Over 5 percent of the world's population requires rehabilitation (hearing aids or treatment) to address their disabling hearing loss. Disabling hearing loss refers to hearing loss greater than 35 decibels in the better-hearing ear.

Over thirty percent of people over age 65 experience hearing loss, while over forty percent of people over 75 have hearing loss.

Our hearing dramatically impacts our overall health. In addition, hearing loss can affect a person's educational and job opportunities due to impaired communication. Social withdrawal is expected due to reduced access to services and difficulty communicating with others.

Multiple studies have shown a link between hearing loss and dementia in older adults, with people who have hearing loss being more likely to develop dementia than those without:

Mild Hearing Loss: Doubles the risk

Moderate Hearing Loss: Triples the risk

Severe Hearing Loss: Five times the risk

According to Jeffrey Lewis, President and CEO of the EMC Health Foundation, "Our goal is to increase access to hearing services and rehabilitation devices, removing the cost barrier to care and improving long-term health and mental health outcomes of seniors 55 and older. A partnership with USF and COSTCO will guarantee quality hearings and access to people through our partnership with COSTCO."
