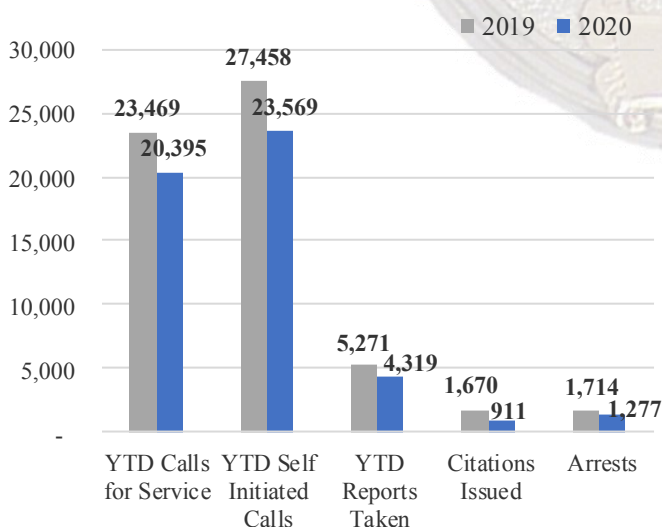

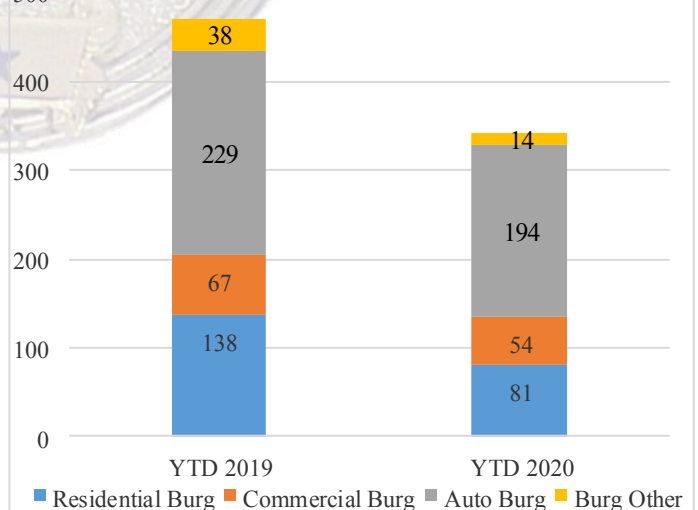

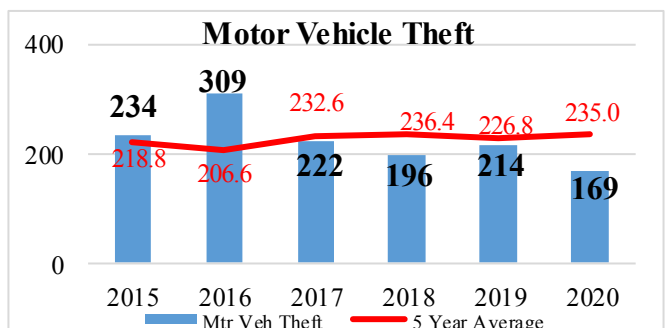
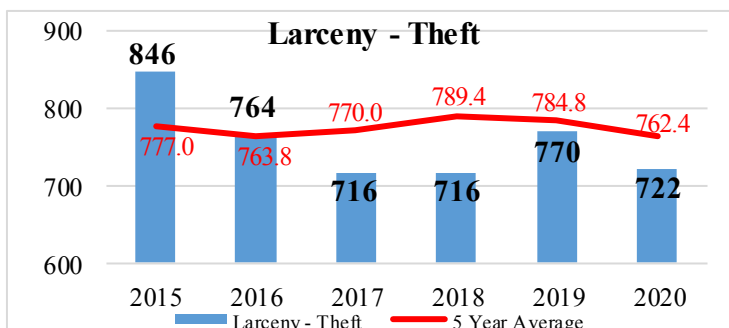
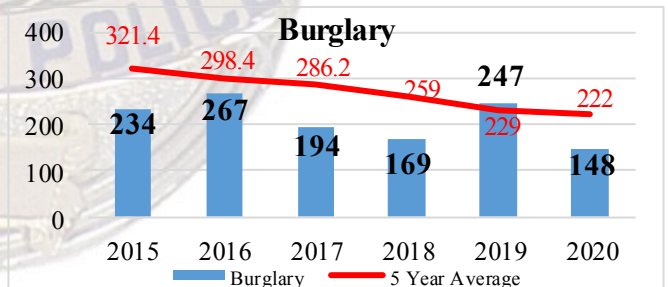
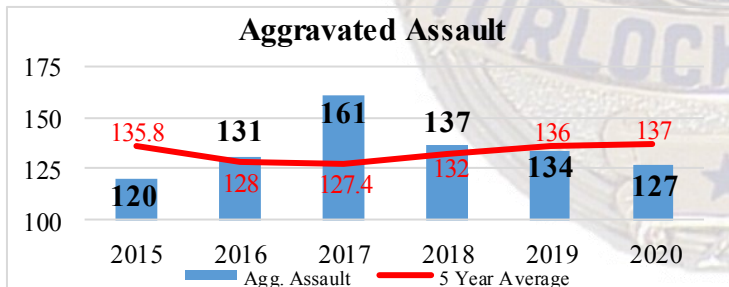
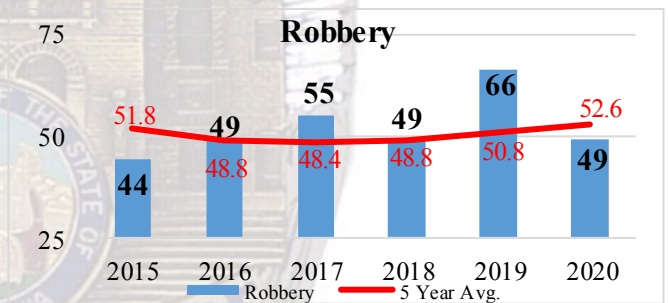
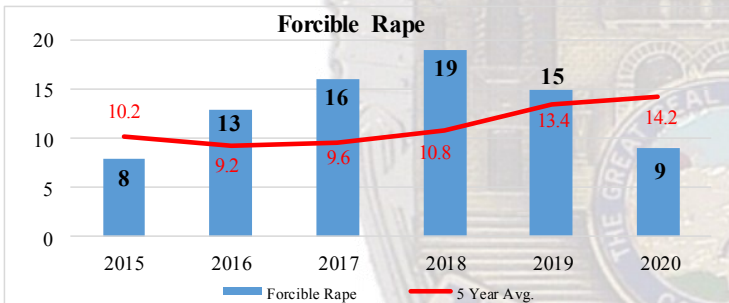
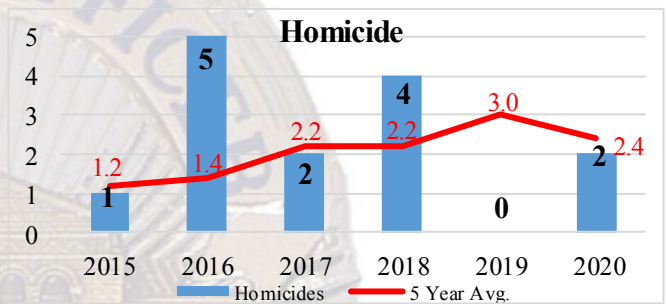
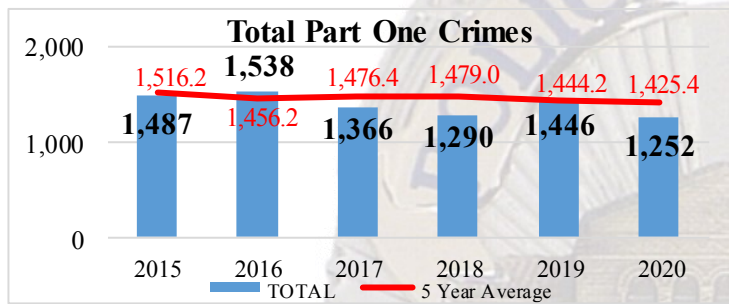
Burglaries by Type - YTD '19 vs. YTD '20
