The COVID-19 pandemic has greatly impacted the Turlock Police Department’s reductions shown in this report. COVID-19 forced businesses to close and social gatherings to stop, resulting in reductions of calls for service, police reports, officers’ self initiated activity, traffic collisions, arrests, crime rate, etc., during the months March through September; however, violent crime, such as aggravated assault and homicide rates, have increased as our staffing levels continue to decrease.

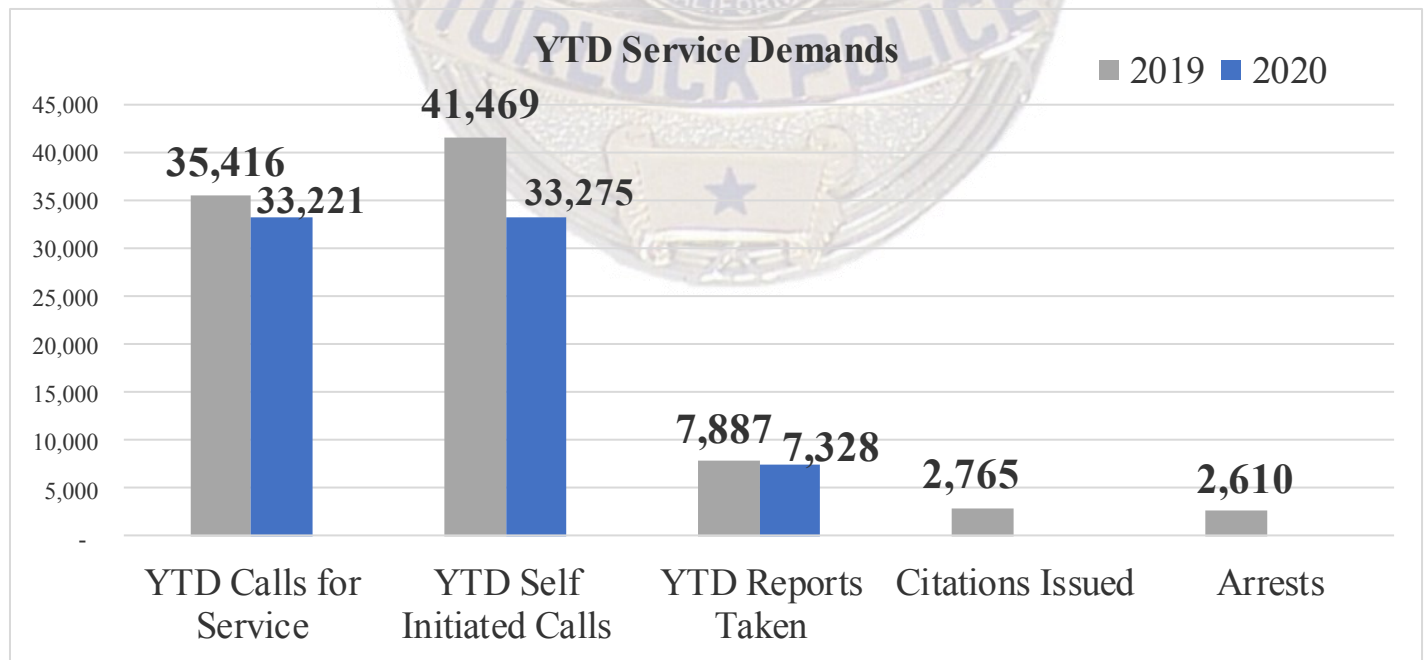
