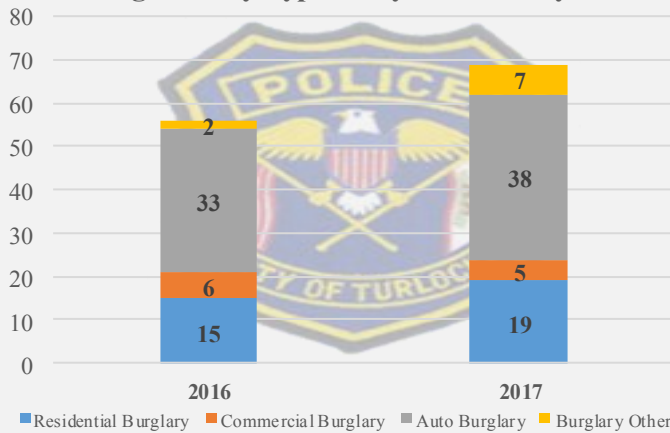

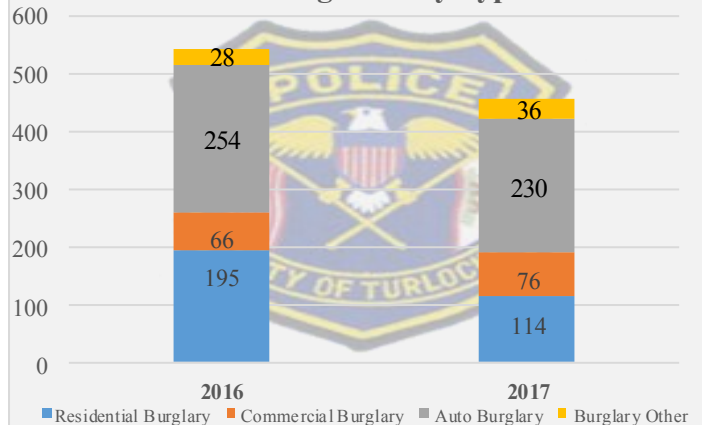

2. TNET assisted STANCATT with surveillance of a stolen vehicle and then a high risk stop on the vehicle. Over 20 pounds of methamphetamine and over \$80,000 was seized after the arrest of the 2 subjects involved.

PROACTIVE PATROL EFFORTS:

1. Animal Services visited 94 individual residences for proactive license enforcement.
2. Patrol the Traffic Safety Unit and VIPS assisted with traffic control and extra patrol for full 10-day Stanislaus County Fair. The Traffic Unit staged several traffic message boards around the area for road closure information.
3. The Traffic Safety unit conducted daily extra patrols for traffic enforcement around the construction site of Hawkeye / N. Golden State.
4. Animal Services staff assisted Mariposa Animal Services with animals who have been displaced from the fires.

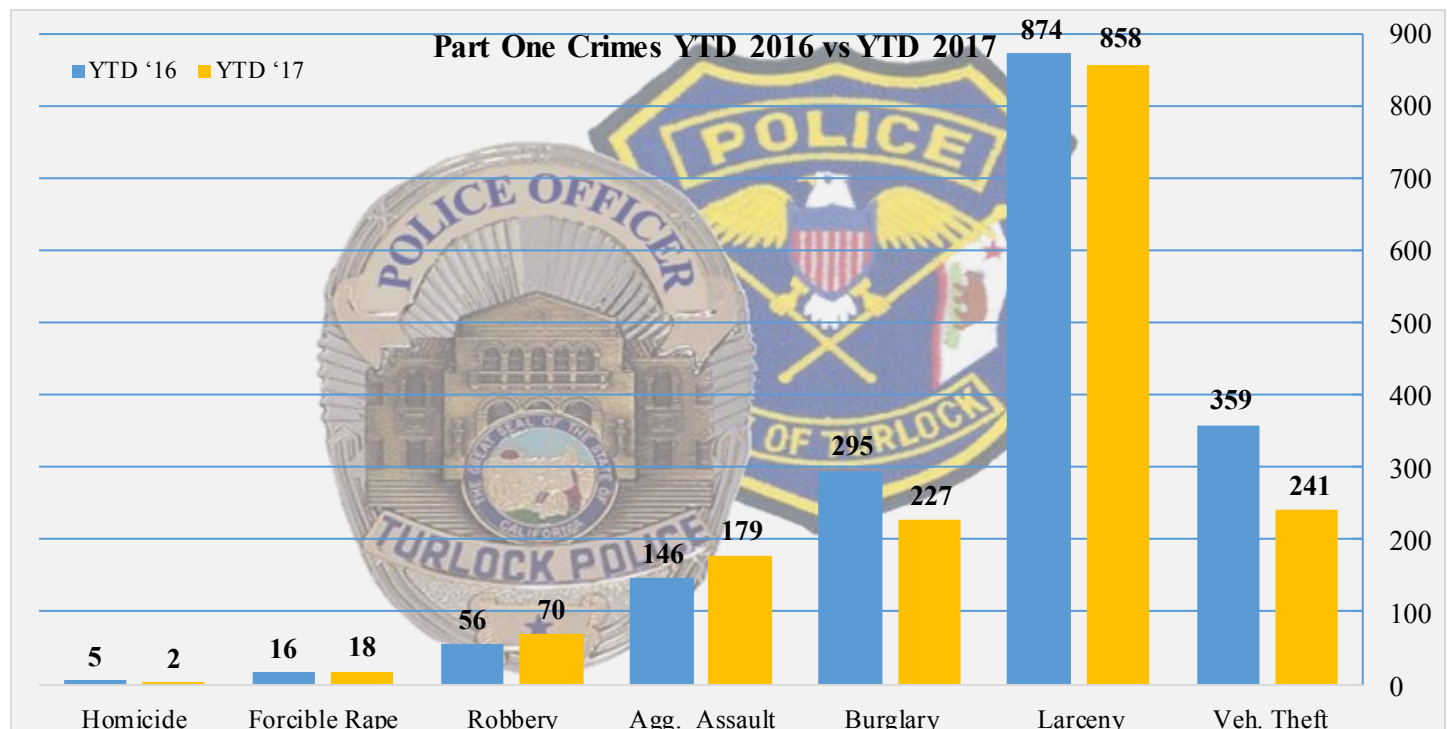

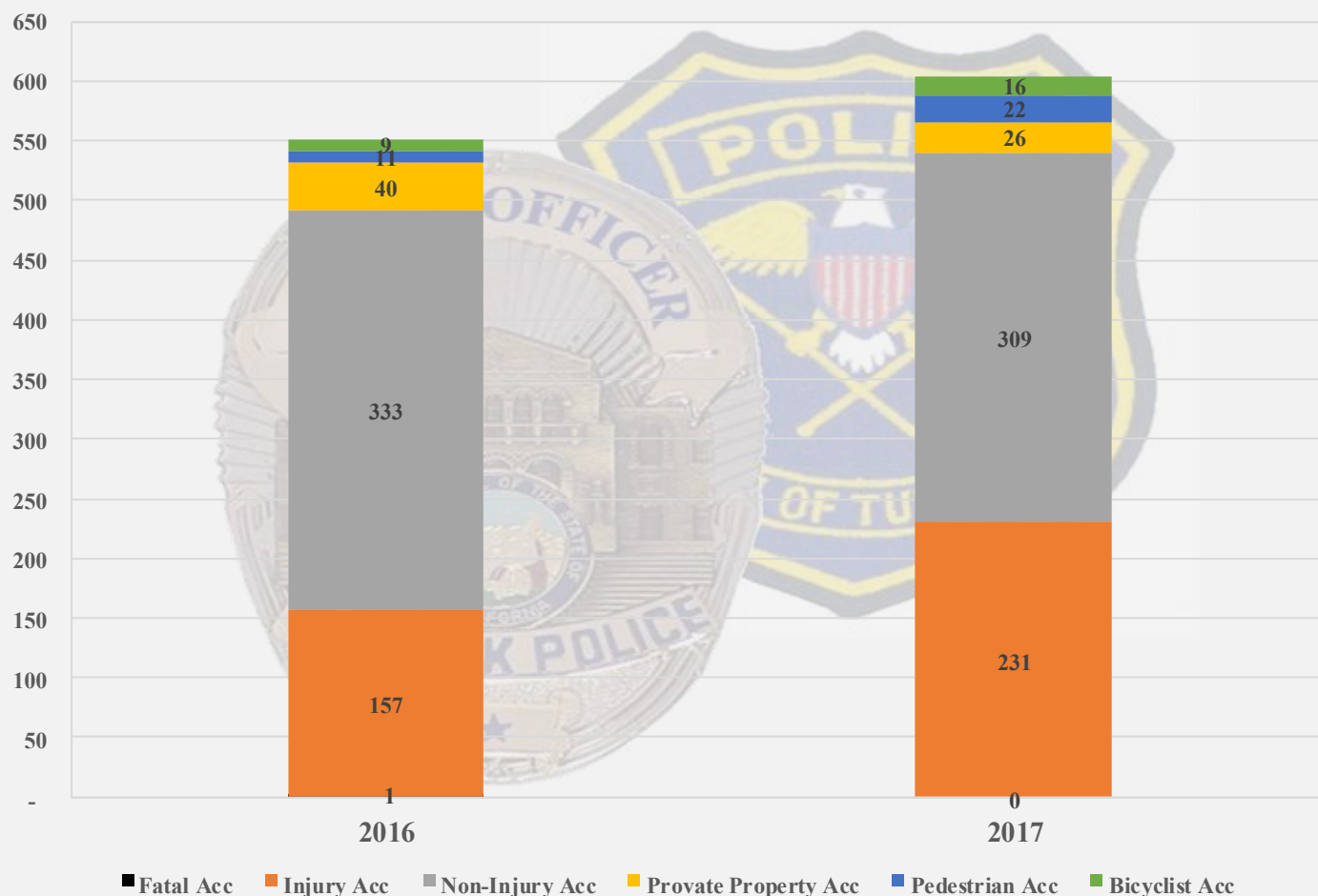
