- 2. TNET assisted STANCATT with surveillance of a stolen vehicle and then a high risk stop on the vehicle. Over 20 pounds of methamphetamine and over \$80,000 was seized after the arrest of the 2 subjects involved.

#### PROACTIVE PATROL EFFORTS:

- 1. Animal Services visited 94 individual residences for proactive license enforcement.
- 2. Patrol the Traffic Safety Unit and VIPS assisted with traffic control and extra patrol for full 10-day Stanislaus County Fair. The Traffic Unit staged several traffic message boards around the area for road closure information.
- 3. The Traffic Safety unit conducted daily extra patrols for traffic enforcement around the construction site of Hawkeye / N. Golden State.
- 4. Animal Services staff assisted Mariposa Animal Services with animals who have been displaced from the fires.




